



Group Visit Form Art Gallery

1. Art Gallery group visits are available to groups with children of all ages, however, most gallery activities are designed for children ages 4 and up.
2. Art Gallery group visits consist of open time for your group to experience our North and South galleries, and our Family Zone. Please note: The North and South galleries will be periodically closed for new exhibit installation. These "downtimes" will alternate to allow at least one gallery to be open to the public, at all times.
3. A museum staff member will greet the groups in front of the museum. The staff members will discuss museum guidelines, and will provide a general overview of the museum.
4. Gallery Educators will be available to answer questions and provide information for visitors.
5. A minimum ratio of 1 adult per ten children is required for all Art Gallery groups. Art Gallery groups are all self-guided, unless a guided tour is requested.
6. Please remember that all artwork in the gallery spaces are "only look" items. For hands-on fun, interactive activities are located throughout the gallery.
7. Please remind teachers and chaperones that photography is not permitted in the areas that contain artwork. However, photos can be taken in the activity areas.
10. Food and drinks (including water) can be left in your vehicle or can be temporarily stored in our lobby area.
11. Museum staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
