



## Group Visit Form ArtVille

1. ArtVille is an early childhood learning space designed for children ages 4 years old and younger.
2. ArtVille is parent-child interactive learning space. Group leaders/caregivers are required to stay with their group of children at all times. Group leaders/caregivers that are not consistently providing supervision of the children in their care may be posing a safety hazard for others and therefore may be asked to relocate their group to another museum space.
3. Children over the age of 4 are welcome in ArtVille, however if they are not using the space appropriately, or if they are posing a safety hazard to our younger visitors, they will be asked to relocate to the Art Gallery space with their caregiver.
4. A museum staff member will greet the groups at the Visitor Services Desk. The staff members will discuss museum guidelines, and will provide a general overview of the museum.
5. Gallery Educators will be available to answer questions and provide information for visitors.
6. A ratio of 1 adult per five children is required for all ArtVille groups. ArtVille groups are all self-guided.
7. Shoes and/or socks are required in the ArtVille space. The Tot Square area for children ages 2 and under in a "socks only" space.
8. Due to space limitations, strollers are not permitted in ArtVille. Stroller parking is located just outside the entrance to ArtVille.
9. Please remind teachers and chaperones that photography is not permitted in the areas that contain artwork. However, photos can be taken in the activity areas.
10. Food and drinks (including water) can be left in your vehicle or can be temporarily stored in our lobby area.
11. Museum staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
