



ARIZONA MUSEUM FOR YOUTH VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Volunteer Title: EXHIBITION DESIGN VOLUNTEER

Accountable to: AMY Exhibition Coordinator

Purpose: The Exhibition Design Volunteer will work in an exhibition fabrication warehouse setting with other museum staff in the preparation of an upcoming exhibition.

Specific Duties:

1. Assist the Curator and Exhibition Coordinator with basic art installation.
2. Painting walls, sanding, spackling, and preparing wall labels.
3. Limited use of power tools. Must be supervised when using power tools.

Qualifications: Ability to work in an environment that may be noisy due to the use of power tools, generators, and other loud equipment and follow all safety rules in regards to the equipment. While working in a shop it may be necessary to wear safety glasses or other personal protective equipment. Lifting required up to 50 pounds.

Skills: Knowledge of power tools, such as a screw gun, is highly desirable. Knowledge of other small tools such as hammer, screwdrivers, and wrenches may be necessary.

Experience: Some prior experience in building, painting, installation, construction or art handling is desirable.

Special Requirements: Requires a background check if over 18.

Time Commitment: 4 to 12 hours a week.
